



## Scholarships

---

The Office of Nuclear Energy's Integrated University Program (IUP) funds undergraduate scholarships as part of the U.S. Department of Energy's (DOE) ongoing commitment to educating the next generation of nuclear scientists and engineers. Scholars receive a 1-year, \$7,500 award to pursue their undergraduate degrees at U.S. universities and colleges. Students can apply in subsequent years.

### Applicants must be:

- U.S. citizens or legal permanent residents
- At least a sophomore in college when the award begins
- Enrolled in an IUP-accepted college or university
- Studying nuclear science or engineering or a related field
- A student with a cumulative GPA of 3.25 or higher

### Applicants must provide:

- A Personal Career Goals essay identifying the applicant's long-term career goals and how the applicant's program of study/career goals align to the DOE-NE mission
- Three reference letters
- Official college transcripts
- ACT or SAT scores

Since FY 2009, DOE has awarded 337 undergraduate scholarships to students from 50 U.S. universities and colleges.
