Tony Feric is the Federal Program Manager for the Gateway for Accelerated Innovation in Nuclear (GAIN) Program and leads the Office of Nuclear Energy's collaborations with the Office of Technology Transitions (OTT), including the Technology Commercialization Fund (TCF), Energy Program for Innovation Clusters (EPIC), Energy I-Corps, and EnergyTech University Prize. He will also be supporting the University Reactor Sharing and Outreach and University Nuclear Research Infrastructure Revitalization efforts.

Prior to joining the Office of Nuclear Energy as a Program Manager, Feric spent two years working as an ORISE Post-doctoral Science, Technology and Policy Fellow with DOE's Office of Fossil Energy and Carbon Management. He was assigned to the Carbon Dioxide Removal Division and evaluated a variety of pathways for capturing and sequestering CO₂ directly from the air and/or oceans.

Feric received his master's and PhD in Chemical Engineering from Columbia University and a Bachelor of Science in Chemical Engineering from the University of Maryland College Park.
